#### What is PTAC?

- PTAC was designed to assist businesses (focusing on small businesses) with federal, state and local government contracting.
- The program is funded by both the federal government and the Snohomish County Economic Development Council



#### **Bid Match**

- Electronically search government websites for contracting opportunities
- Search procurement websites such as FedBizOpps, the Procurement Gateway, NECO (Navy), Washington State Department of GA
- Can tailor bid match to each company
- Bids notices are sent to clients via email
- Bid match limitations: bids must be listed on a website
